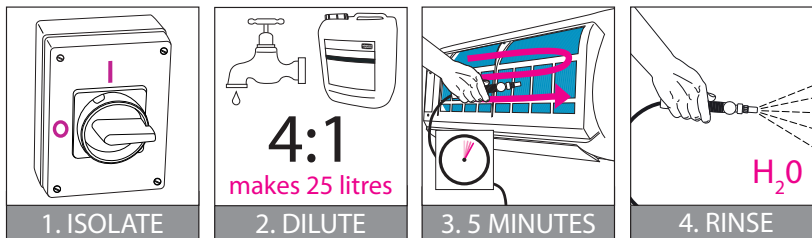

Directions of use



Dilution 1:4 parts water. Turn off unit and isolate electrics. Apply diluted CondensCide® with a low pressure sprayer set on a coarse spray pattern. Saturate areas to be cleaned and keep wet for 5 minutes. Contaminated CondensCide® will drain away as normal condensate. After cleaning, flush thoroughly with fresh water. Let surfaces air dry before re-starting system.

When used as directed, CondensCide® will control bacteria and fungi – including *Legionella pneumophila*, *Salmonella typhimurium*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Eschericia coli*, and *Aspergillus niger*.

CondensCide® is safe to use where a condensate pump is fitted. Use CondensCide® in line with normal maintenance schedule.

Store upright in a cool, dry place.
