These buildups are commonly found in the condensate lines draining away from chilled storage and dairy cabinets and can cause blockages and the spread of bacteria.

DrainSafe® is registered by NSF. This product is acceptable for use in sewage and/or drain lines (L1) in and around food processing areas.

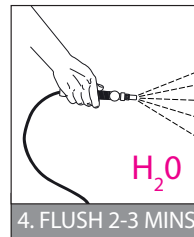
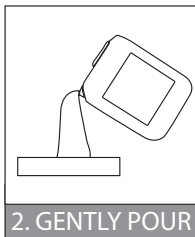

Directions of use



Remove excess water from condensate tray, and condensate drain, if possible. Gently pour DrainSafe into the tray and allow it to enter the drain. Ensure DrainSafe® does not come into contact with foodstuffs.

Allow DrainSafe to remain in condensate tray and drain for five minutes or until obstruction is cleared. Flush out with fresh water for 2-3 minutes. Repeat as necessary until obstruction is cleared.
